ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On October 3, 2008, and as amended on October 20, 2008, the Celina City Schools filed a letter requesting, pursuant to Section 4511.63, Revised Code, a Commission exemption for school buses from stopping at certain grade crossings within the City of Celina, Mercer County, Ohio.
- (2) On November 5, 2008, the Commission's Transportation Department Rail Division filed its report of investigation of the exemption request.
- (3) By entry issued November 7, 2008, a hearing was scheduled for November 21, 2008. The hearing was conducted on November 21, 2008.
- (4) After the hearing, the attorney examiner was informed by Staff that R. J. Corman Western Ohio Lines (Corman), which operates on the track at the four crossings identified in Finding (1), had not been properly served regarding the exemption request. The attorney examiner believes it is appropriate that Corman have the opportunity to file comments. Therefore, Corman will have until January 30, 2009, to file any comments that it wishes to make.

ORDERED, That R. J. Corman file comments no later than January 30, 2009. It is, further,
