

In Geauga County, government officials have hosted multiple meetings on wind power, resulting in a number of residents expressing interest in the idea. However the discussions have yet to bear much tangible fruit.

"If you're residential, there's not a grant program out there for you right now," said Anita Stocker, the county economic and community development director. "You hate to tell someone (to) put a \$30,000 windmill up when they might have grants next year.






