ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On February 7, 2007, the Commission approved the issuance of renewed Certificate Nos. 07-136(1) and 07-137(1) to Liberty Power Delaware LLC and Liberty Power Holdings LLC (collectively, joint applicants), respectively, for the provision of competitive retail electric service. The expiration date for these certificates is February 7, 2009.
- (2) On January 16, 2009, joint applicants filed a motion for an extension of the expiration of the existing certificates and a request for an expedited ruling pursuant to Rule 4901-1-12(C) and (F), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.). In their motion, joint applicants state that, as a result of the pendency of an urgent business matter and limited staff resources, they were unable to file renewal applications until January 14, 2009, which was six days after the January 8, 2009, filing deadline. Therefore, joint applicants request that the Commission extend Certificate Nos. 07-136(1) and 07-137(1) for six days, until February 13, 2009, in order that no interruption of service occurs.
- (3) The attorney examiner believes that an extension of the expiration date of the Certificate Nos. 07-136(1) and 07-137(1) until February 13, 2009, is warranted so that joint applicants' customers will not be adversely affected while the renewal applications are under consideration.



ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.


