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<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc., (Vectren) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On February 18, 2009, Vectren filed an application requesting approval of changes to its Tariff Sheet 54 to reflect a change in its Unaccounted For Gas Percentage. Tariff Sheet 54 contains language which states that "...the Unaccounted For Gas Percentage shall be adjusted periodically by the Company, through updating of this Sheet No. 54, after approval by the Commission, to reflect any changes in the system unaccounted for percentage." Vectren proposes to change its Unaccounted For Gas percentage from 1.6 percent to 1.5 percent. This revision is based on the results of Vectren's most recent annual review of its Unaccounted For Gas Percentage.
- (3) This Commission has reviewed the application and finds it is reasonable and in the public interest and should be approved.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request of Vectren for a change to its Unaccounted for Gas Percentage in Tariff Sheet 54 be approved. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Vectren be authorized to file complete copies of tariffs in final form consistent with this Entry. Vectren shall file one copy in this case docket and one copy shall be filed in its TRF docket (or may file electronically as directed in Case No. 06-900-AU-WVR). It is, further,

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ORDERED, That nothing in this Finding and Order shall be binding upon this Commission in any future proceeding or investigation involving the justness or reasonableness of any rate, charge, or regulation of Vectren. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon Vectren.
