ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (Dominion) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On June 18, 2008, the Commission approved the terms of a stipulation in this proceeding. The stipulation provided that Dominion would hold an auction to secure natural gas supplies for Standard Service Offer and Standard Choice Offer (SCO) customers. In the approved stipulation, the parties agreed to develop standard terms and conditions under which SCO commodity service would be provided and Dominion agreed to seek Commission approval of such terms and conditions in its tariffs. In addition, the Commission's opinion and order also required Dominion to file an application seeking Commission approval of terms and conditions regarding how the SCO commodity service will be provided in conjunction with Dominion's energy choice transportation service or large volume energy choice transportation service.
- (3) On January 30, 2009, in compliance with the stipulation and the opinion and order, Dominion filed an application requesting approval of proposed revisions to its tariff covering SCO Commodity Service, Original Sheet B-SCO, which will be the default service for sales customers that are choice eligible, and to its

tariff covering Monthly Variable Rate (MVR) Commodity Service, Original Sheet B-MVR, which will be the default service for choice customers returning to sales service.

- (4) In its application for approval, Dominion explains that, in accordance with the stipulation and the Commission's opinion and order, it circulated these proposed tariffs to all parties in this proceeding and received no comments from any party.
- (5) This Commission has reviewed the application and finds that it is reasonable and in the public interest and that the proposed tariff revisions should be approved. Both tariff sheets are consistent with the Commission's prior approvals in this proceeding.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the tariffs Standard Choice Offer (SCO) Commodity Service, Original Sheet B-SCO, and Monthly Variable Rate (MVR) Commodity Service, Original Sheet B-MVR, as submitted on January 30, 2009, be approved. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Dominion be authorized to file complete copies of tariffs in final form, consistent with this entry. Dominion shall file one copy in this case docket and one copy in its TRF docket (or may file electronically as directed in Case No 06-900-AU-WVR). It is, further,

ORDERED, That nothing in this entry shall be binding upon this Commission in any future proceeding or investigation involving the justness or reasonableness of any rate, charge, or regulation of Dominion. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record in this proceeding.


