ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On January 2, 2009, Schoolhouse Outfitters, LLC dba School Outfitters.com (Outfitters) filed a complaint against Duke Energy Ohio (Duke), alleging an interruption in service from September 14-17, 2008. Outfitters contends that, because of the power outage, it could not operate for three days, resulting in \$85,000 in lost sales.
- (2) Duke answered on January 22, 2009, by admitting that Outfitters' service was interrupted from September 14-17, 2009, but adding that the cause was high winds resulting from the remnants of Hurricane Ike. Duke asserts that despite its best efforts, service could not be restored for several days. Duke denies any other allegations made by Outfitters.
- (3) On February 4, 2009, Outfitters filed a letter stating that it wishes to withdraw its complaint.
- (4) The Commission considers the February 4, 2009 request made by Outfitters to be reasonable and, accordingly, approves the request to withdraw the complaint.


It is, therefore,


