The Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel ("OCC"), the representative of residential consumers, moves the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission" or "PUCO"), pursuant to Ohio Adm. Code 4901-1-12 and 4901-1-13, for permission to file comments out-of -time and for an extension of time for all interested persons to file reply comments in this proceeding. Specifically, OCC requests that it be granted until March 23, 2009, to file comments and that OCC and all other interested persons have until April 2, 2009, to file reply comments. In the PUCO's Entry of February 25, 2009, comments were due by March 16, 2009, and reply comments are due by March 26, 2009.
