Dear Ms. Jenkins:

On March 16, 2009, Embarq Local Operating Companies filed Transmittal No. 66, with the Federal Communications Commission. The revisions made to Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 will become effective March 31, 2009. These revisions include within band, within cap rate adjustments for special access channel mileage rates associated with DS1 services in the states of Florida and North Carolina. In addition, revisions are made to the Revenue Volume Discount Plan (RVDP). These include the following:

- Adjustment to the minimum monthly revenue tiers;
- Change to the commitment level provisions to allow customers to add new circuits after completion of 2 years of the 3 year commitment period;
- Addition of tariff language allowing customers to extend the RVDP for up to an additional
   12 months at the completion of their initial 3 year commitment period; and
- Addition of tariff language to address the renewal of an RVDP at the end of the initial commitment period.

This filing is being made on 15 day's notice under the Federal Communications Commission's streamlined filing procedures and proposes within band, within cap rate adjustments for special access channel mileage rates associated with DS1 services in the states of Florida and North Carolina.

In addition, Embarq LOC proposes revisions to the Revenue Volume Discount Plan (RVDP) in order to adjust the minimum monthly revenue tiers; revise the commitment level provisions to allow customers to add new circuits after completion of 2 years of the 3 year commitment period; and add tariff language so that customers can extend their RVDP for up to an additional 12 month period at the completion of their initial 3 year commitment period and renew their RVDP. The revisions to the minimum monthly revenue tiers have been shared with the customer in advance and they have agreed with the changes and the benefits that will be received from these revisions. The proposed minimum monthly revenue tiers will incorporate additional credits that are currently provided under pricing flexibility Contract Nos. 07-004 and 08-006.
