ENTRY ON REHEARING

The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 15, 2006, Revolution Communications, Ltd. (Revolution) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T). Among other things, Revolution alleged that AT&T billed improperly for charges relating to the provisioning of new service orders and did not bill properly for a certain type of telecommunications traffic. On February 4, 2009, the Commission issued an opinion and order deciding the issues in Revolution's favor.
- (2) Section 4903.10, Revised Code, indicates that any party who has entered an appearance in a Commission proceeding may apply for rehearing with respect to any matters determined by filing an application within 30 days after the entry of the order upon the journal of the Commission. Under Rule 4901-1-35(B), O.A.C., any party may file a memorandum contra within ten days after the filing of an application for rehearing.
- (3) On March 6, 2009, AT&T filed an application for rehearing of the Order, along with an accompanying memorandum in support.
- (4) The Commission finds that the application for rehearing filed by AT&T should be granted for the limited purpose of allowing the Commission additional time to consider the issues raised on rehearing.


It is, therefore,
