The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 27, 2009, the Cleveland Municipal School District (CMSD) filed an amended application to establish a reasonable arrangement with the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI) for electric service to its facilities located in Cleveland, Ohio. CMSD states that it is within the certified service area of and obtains electricity from CEI, a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code. CMSD is requesting that the Commission establish an arrangement or schedule for electric service from CEI.
- (2) By entry dated April 1, 2009, the attorney examiner set this matter for hearing on April 9, 2009. On April 2, 2009, CMSD filed a motion for a continuance of the hearing date to April 23, 2009. CMSD represents that no other party is opposed to its motion.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that CMSD's motion for a continuance is reasonable and should be granted.
- (4) Accordingly, the hearing in this proceeding should be rescheduled for April 23, 2009, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, Hearing Room 11-C, 180 E. Broad St., Columbus, Ohio 43215.
