TARIFF FORMAT

- A. Page Numbering Page numbers appear in the upper right corner of the page. Pages are numbered sequentially. However, new pages are occasionally added to the tariff. When a new page is added between pages already in effect, a decimal is added. For example, a new page added between Page 14 and 15 will be 14.1
- B. Page Revision Numbers Revision numbers also appear in the upper right corner of each page. These numbers are used to determine the most current page version on file with the PUCO. For example, the 4th revised Page 14 cancels the 3rd revised Page 14. Because of various suspension periods, deferrals, etc. the PUCO follows in their tariff approval process, the most current sheet number on file with the PUCO is not always the tariff page in effect. Consult the Check Sheet for the sheet currently in effect.
- C. **Paragraph Numbering Sequence** There are nine levels of paragraph coding. Each level of coding is subservient to its next higher level:

APPLICATION OF THE TARIFF

This tariff governs the Carrier's late payment and check charges for services that originate and terminate in Ohio. Specific service descriptions and rates are available on the company's website at www.pronetcommunications.com.

The Company's services are available to Residential and Non-Residential customers.

SECTION 1 - TECHNICAL TERMS

"Carrier," "Company" or "Utility" refers to ProNet Communications, Incorporated.

"Customer" or "End User" means any person, firm, corporation, or governmental entity who has applied for and is granted service or who is responsible for payment of service regardless of the identity of the actual user of the service.

"PUCO" refers to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. This is the regulatory authority of the state of Ohio having jurisdiction over public service corporations operating in Ohio.

"Residential" customer is a customer who has telephone service at a dwelling or who uses the service primarily for domestic or social purposes. All other customers are non-residential customers.

"Service" means any telecommunications service(s) provided by the Carrier under the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

SECTION 2 – Charges

2.1 <u>Late Payment Charges</u>

Late payment charges will be computed at a rate of 1.5% per month if invoices are not paid by the due date. The late payment charge is applied to the total unpaid balance due and outstanding.

2.2 Return Check Charge

If the Company receives a check or authorization to process an electronic payment from a Customer in payment for service rendered or for any other reason of indebtedness and which is returned from or denied by the bank or responsible agency due to insufficient or uncollected funds, closed account, apparent tampering, missing signature or endorsement, or for any other reason, the Company shall apply a service charge of \$30.00 for each instance.

The charge shall be applied to Customer's monthly billing in addition to any other charges which may apply under the Company's then current rate schedule. Payment rendered by check or electronic means, which is subsequently dishonored shall not constitute payment nor shall it relieve Customer from the obligation to render payment to the Utility. Repayment by valid means: money order, certified check, or other means which guarantee customer's payment to the utility shall be subject to the same original terms of the bill and will not deter the Utility's provision for termination for non-payment of service.
