ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On September 17, 2008, the Commission issued new rules, contained in Chapter 4901:1-36, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), to establish procedures for the implementation of transmission cost recovery riders authorized by Section 4928.05(A)(2), Revised Code, as amended by Amended Substitute Senate Bill 221. The new rules were effective on April 2, 2009.
- (2) Rule 4901:1-36-03, O.A.C., requires electric utilities with approved transmission cost recovery riders to update the rider pursuant to a schedule set forth by Commission order. Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L), Columbus Southern Power Company and Ohio Power Company (AEP-Ohio), Duke Energy Ohio (Duke) and Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company and The Toledo Edison Company (FE) have Commission-approved, or have applied for, transmission cost recovery riders. Accordingly, the Commission will set the following annual schedule for the filing of transmission cost recovery riders:

	<u>Filing Date</u>	<u>For Rates Effective On</u>
DP&L	February 15	May 1
AEP-Ohio	April 16	July 1
Duke	July 17	October 1
FE	October 17	January 1

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- (3) This annual schedule shall be effective commencing with the 2009 filings, except for DP&L, which filed its application for a transmission cost recovery rider on March 27, 2009, and AEP-Ohio, which is directed to make its 2009 filing within 30 days after this entry.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That each electric utility with an approved transmission cost recovery rider comply with the schedule set forth in Finding (2). It is, further,
