The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On February 27, 2009, The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (DEO) filed an application requesting an adjustment to its automated meter reading (AMR) cost recovery charge, consistent with the Commission's October 15, 2008, order approving the stipulation in In the Matter of the Application of East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion East Ohio for Authority to Increase Rates for its Gas Distribution Service, Case No. 07-829-GA-AIR, et. al.
- (2) By entry issued April 6, 2009, the attorney examiner, *inter alia*, granted the motion to intervene filed by the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) and established the procedural schedule for this case. The entry scheduled the hearing in this matter for April 22, 2009.
- (3) Rule 4901-1-29(A)(1)(h), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), provides that expert testimony in these types of proceedings must be filed and served no later than seven days before the commencement of the hearing.
- (4) On April 14, 2009, the parties in this case filed a joint motion requesting that a schedule be set for the submission of testimony different than that required by Rule 4901-1-29(A)(1)(h), O.A.C. Specifically, the parties request that DEO file its testimony on April 15, 2009, and that OCC and Staff file their testimony on April 20, 2009.
- (5) The attorney examiner finds that the joint motion filed by the parties on April 14, 2009, is reasonable and should be granted. Therefore, DEO should file its testimony on April 15, 2009, and OCC and Staff should file their testimony on April 20, 2009.
