MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

The Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel ("OCC") requests a subpoena *duces* tecum, pursuant to Ohio Adm. Code 4901-1-25, to command David M. Roush, Manager of Regulated Pricing and Analysis for AEPSC,² to appear for the hearing scheduled for Thursday, April 30, 2009, to submit to cross-examination by OCC in this proceeding until completed.

This case involves a unique arrangement between Ormet and AEP. The unique arrangement is conditioned upon AEP's requirement that 100% of all revenues lost due to the arrangement (delta revenues) are collected. The impact on AEP's residential customers is a subject of this proceeding and a primary concern of OCC.

As part of the discovery responses submitted to OCC by AEP in this case, Mr.

Roush was identified as one of the persons responding to OCC's interrogatories related to the proposed Ormet Unique Arrangement. In addition, Mr. Roush's position as Manager of Regulated Pricing and Analysis for AEPSC would make it likely for Mr. Roush to be

knowledgeable about the details of the current and proposed agreements between AEP and Ormet. Mr. Roush's full participation in the examination will facilitate a full and complete development of the case before the Commission, including the ultimate record upon which the Commission will base its decision

Additionally, the OCC requests the PUCO to command Mr. Roush to bring with him, for delivery to OCC at 9:30 a.m. on said day and at said place: 1) All documents in the possession or control of Mr. Roush that contain any applicable information on actual or proposed rate schedules, agreements, and delta revenues between any and all companies affiliated with AEP and Ormet; 2) all documents in the possession or control of Mr. Roush containing correspondence related to the agreements or proposed agreements referenced in the preceding sentence involving Ormet or other customers of AEP (or their representatives, including representatives of membership organizations to which the customer belongs) and representatives of any AEP-affiliated company; and 3) all documents in the possession or control of Mr. Roush pertaining to the aforementioned agreements or proposed agreements. The period of time covered by the aforementioned materials should begin on January 1, 2009, and continue to the date of the examination. This information is central to understanding and addressing the issues related to AEP's proposed unique arrangement with Ormet. Therefore, OCC moves the Commission to issue the requested duces tecum subpoena, in order to facilitate a thorough examination and create a complete record on the issues in this case.
