## **ENTRY**

## The Commission finds:

- (1) The above-referenced complaint was filed on February 17, 2009. In the complaint, Kyle D. Scheidler alleged that Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke, company) over-estimated gas usage at his residence in a revenue recovery calculation.
- (2) On March 5, 2009, Duke filed an answer stating that the company was without sufficient knowledge at that time to admit or deny the allegations in the complaint.
