Savings are possible through a concept called government aggregation, where City officials bring together citizens to gain group buying power for the purchase of electricity from a retail electric generation provider certified by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. Barberton voters approved this program in November 2000.

There is no cost for enrollment and you will not be charged a switching fee. <u>You do not need to do anything to participate</u>. The City researched options for competitive electricity pricing for you. We have again chosen FirstEnergy Solutions Corp., a subsidiary of FirstEnergy Corp., to provide you with electric generation – or the competitive portion of your electric bill – through May 2012.

As a member of this aggregation, you are guaranteed to save 7 percent off your Price to Compare in 2009, 3.5 percent off in years 2010 and 2011 and 2.5 percent off January through May 2012. Your Price to Compare consists of bypassable generation and transmission related components, which are the charges associated with the costs for purchased power and to deliver the power through the transmission system.

To estimate what your savings per kilowatt-hour (KWH) will be through this program, locate your Price to Compare on your electric bill. Divide your Price to Compare by 100, then multiply by the percentage discounts listed above by year to determine your savings per KWH. Multiply that number by your total monthly usage.
