REQUEST OF UNITED TELEPHONE COMPANY OF OHIO DBA EMBARQ FOR REVIEW OF A DECISION OF NEUSTAR - POOLING ADMINISTRATOR

United Telephone Company of Ohio d/b/a Embarq ("Embarq") respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO" or "Commission") direct NeuStar, the Pooling Administrator ("PA"), to provide Embarq with an uncontaminated consecutive thousand number block in the Howland wire center of the Warren, Ohio rate center to satisfy the request of Embarq's customer, 910th Air Force Reserve Base ("910th") located in Vienna, Ohio. 910th is beginning a seven digit-dialing Department of Defense conversion project, and this consecutive number request is critical to the completion of the project.

BACKGROUND

910th contacted Embarq requesting a consecutive group of Direct Inward Dialing ("DID") numbers for its use. They requested consecutive numbers in the 330-609-2000-3999 range. They cannot use the 1, 8, and 9 blocks. They already utilize the 1 block, and 8 and 9 are used for accessing outside lines.

Embarq reviewed the customer's request and determined that it did not have the requested consecutive number block available within the Warren rate center and requested a formal letter from 910th for the consecutive DID numbers.

On May 13, 2009, 910th provided an official request for the consecutive DID numbers on its letterhead. (Exhibit A).

On May 22, 2009 Embarq submitted a Thousands Block Application Form - Part 1A to the PA for the assignment of a consecutive uncontaminated thousand number block necessary to meet the 910th request. A copy of this application form is attached. (Exhibit B). Embarq completed the application in accordance with the Thousands Block Number (NXX-X) Pooling Administration Guidelines and completed the necessary Months to Exhaust ("MTE") Certification, attached. (Exhibit C).

On May 22, 2009, the PA, via the Pooling Administration System ("PAS"), denied the request on the grounds that Embarq had not met the rate center-based MTE criteria set forth in the NXX Number (NXX) Pooling Administration Guidelines, notwithstanding the fact that Embarq does not have the numbering resources needed to satisfy its customer's request in the switch at issue. This denial of the application received by Embarq from the PAS system is attached. (Exhibit D).

Under earlier months-to-exhaust procedures, waivers or exceptions were granted where customer hardships were demonstrated or where the service provider's inventory did not have a block of numbers large enough to meet a customer's specific request.

Under existing procedures, the PA looks at the number of months-to-exhaust for the entire rate center without any exceptions. However, paragraph 64 of the FCC's Third Report and Order in the Numbering Resource Optimization docket states that a carrier "... should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due to the carrier's inability to satisfy specific customer request." Also, paragraph 64 indicates that "States may not accommodate requests for specific numbers (i.e. vanity numbers), but may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers." Therefore,

this Commission has the authority to review the PA's decision and reverse it when appropriate.

Embarq's request to obtain the required numbering resources from NeuStar was not processed because Embarq does not meet the two required FCC criteria to obtain numbering resources in the Warren rate center. The FCC requires a months-to-exhaust (MTE) of 6 months or fewer. Embarq is at a 232.32 MTE due to the low growth forecast and inventory that does not qualify for donation. In addition, the FCC requires utilization of 75% or higher, and Embarq is at 49.71%. Thus, neither FCC criteria is met in this case.

The FCC's rules identify a procedure whereby denial of a numbering resource request can be brought to the appropriate state commission for review. 47 CFR § 52.15 (g)(3)(iv) provides:

The NANPA shall withhold numbering resources from any U.S. carrier that fails to comply with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements established in this part. The NANPA shall not issue numbering resources to a carrier without an Operating Company Number (OCN). The NANPA must notify the carrier in writing of its decision to withhold numbering resources within ten (10) days of receiving a request for numbering resources. The carrier may challenge the NANPA's decision to the appropriate state regulatory commission. The state regulatory commission may affirm or overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination of compliance with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements herein.

Embarq submits that 910th's request constitutes special circumstances and demonstrates a clear requirement that warrants the Commission's review and reversal of NeuStar's decision.

CONCLUSION

Embarq respectfully requests that the Commission review and reverse the PA's decision to withhold numbering resources because it violates the intent and requirements of the FCC in allowing carriers access to numbering resources to meet specific customer demands upon a sufficient showing of need. The PA's denial of numbering resources interferes with Embarq's ability to serve its customer, 910th. Embarq requests expedited treatment of its request due to the urgent needs and the timeline of the customer and that the Commission overturn the PA's decision and instruct it to release the numbering resources necessary to meet the needs of 910th.
