

This Application is submitted in conjunction with the Joint Application of Frontier Communications Corporation, New Communications Holdings, Inc and Verizon Communications Inc., whereby the parties seek approval of the acquisition of Verizon North Inc. by Frontier Communications Corporation (the "Transaction").

As described in the Joint Application, the long-distance customers of Verizon Long Distance ("VLD") and Verizon Enterprise Services ("VES") will, as part of the Transaction and consistent with applicable bulk-transfer rules, be transferred to a newly-formed corporation, New Communications Online and Long Distance, Inc. ("NewLD"). NewLD will be a wholly-owned subsidiary of New Communications Holdings, Inc. ("NCH"). As described in the Joint Application, NCH will be merged into Frontier Communications Corporation ("Frontier") and, hence, NewLD will then be a wholly-owned subsidiary Frontier.

Because NewLD will assume responsibility for service to VLD and VES customers, this Application seeks certification of NewLD as a CTS provider, to be effective upon closing of the Transaction. In view of the foregoing, the Applicant refers the Commission to the Joint Application for information pertaining to financial and managerial ability of the Applicant.

The Applicant's proposed tariff will be late-filed, as will a Good-Standing Certificate of the Secretary of State of Ohio. A proposed Notice will also be supplied as Exhibit D.
