The Attorney Examiner finds:

- (1) By entry issued April 29, 2009, the Attorney Examienr concluded that the procedural schedule proposed by the parties to this proceeding complied with the Commission's Opinion and Order (Order) issued on December 17, 2008 and the proposed schedule adopted. In accordance with the adopted procedural schedule, reply comments to company responses are due June 19, 2009.
- (2) On June 12, 2009, the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) filed a motion for a one-week extension of the reply due date, until June 26, 2009. ODOD also request an expedited ruling on its motion. ODOD states that the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) did not receive responses to its discovery requests served upon ODOD, Columbus Southern Power Company and Ohio Power Company (jointly AEP), and Duke Energy Ohio (Duke) in a timely fashion. Therefore, ODOD states that OCC's time to prepare its reply comments has been limited. Accordingly, ODOD requests an extension of time to file reply comments. Further, ODOD states that no affected party objects to the extension or to the issuance of an expedited ruling.
- (3) The Attorney Examiner finds that the request for a one-week extension of time to file reply comments is reasonable, under the circumstances, and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion for an extension of time to file reply comments to the responses of AEP and Duke is granted and the replies due by June 26, 2009. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served on all parties and interested persons of record in this case.
