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DIRECT INWARD AND DIRECT OUTWARD DIALING (DID/DOD) SERVICE

(N)

A. Regulations:

DID/DOD service will be provided, subject to the availability of central office facilities and telephone numbers in the serving central office. Customers utilizing DID/DOD must arrange to provide for interception of all unused telephone numbers assigned by the Telephone Company.

The Company shall provide telephone numbers for exchange service line connections in initial and incremental blocks of twenty (20) each.

The customer shall provide all switching or common equipment located on its premises that is necessary for the provision of DID/DOD service.

B. Rates and Charges:

The following rates and charges are in addition to rates and charges applicable for the central office trunk lines:

Each group of 20 DID/DOD numbers or fraction thereof:	\$174.20	\$ 4.15
