

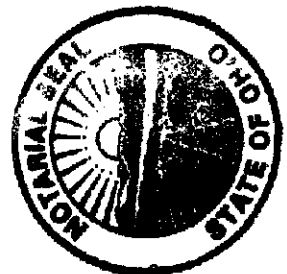

Letter to the Editor

Dear Editor,

The Auglaize County teacher makes \$44,848 per year. This year, they received a raise of \$2,056 or a raise of \$1.60 per hour more into the pension. The teacher salary and benefits are \$48.05 per hour.

They are guaranteed two personal days, sick leave of 15 days, which can accumulate to 220 days in 15 years, and five days for bad weather. In the worst case, this would reduce the teaching days by 24.

The total for four people in administration with salary and benefits is \$450,103. This is \$974.25 for administration for each student.

As for the superintendent, she has 260 contractual days. Her salary, based on 260 days, gives her an hourly wage of \$40.90. By this contract, she has 20 vacation days, 10 holidays and two personal days. If you reduce the work days to 228 days, you have an hourly rate of \$46.02.

When you put in the benefits, you have a package of \$108,869.20 or \$59.68 per year.

These wages and benefits are guaranteed. Teachers get step raises plus percent increases every year.

They are virtually guaranteed a job when they have tenure. Very

few in the education system are fired.

You don't get reduced hours or unpaid work weeks. Rarely are there wage reductions. To get your hours, you include lunch and a free period.

Folks, look at your wages. Are your earnings spiraling upward? You have to ask — can we afford this?

The answer is clearly, no. The board, administration and teachers should figure out a way. I believe much of the levy would go to wages.

'Settlement conference' set for DUI

The postponement of a hearing is no clear indication of settlement talks between squabbling family members.

DAYTON — A federal judge has scheduled a "settlement conference" for Friday, May 1, in the trademark infringement lawsuit filed by the former owner of Dominic's Restaurant against her stepdaughter.

U.S. District Court Judge

Thomas M. Rose postponed until June 8 a hearing on the heart of the case that had been scheduled for today, April 28.

That hearing, on a request for a preliminary injunction, if it goes ahead, will likely include sworn testimony from the parties in the case.

Anne B. Mantia, who

owned Dominic's Restaurant in its final years until it closed in 2007, sued stepdaughter Christie Mantia, the granddaughter of Dominic's founder Dominic Mantia, and two of Christie's business partners in a new and as-yet-unnamed restaurant venture in West Carrollton.

It's not clear whether the "settlement conference" suggests the possibility both sides are negotiating an agreement that would pre-

vent a lengthy court battle.

Nicholas Subashi of Dayton, Christie Mantia's attorney, declined comment Monday.

James M. Morris, Anne Mantia's attorney, said the hearing was postponed "at the defendant's request."

Rose has already granted Anne Mantia a temporary restraining order that prohibits Christie Mantia from using the name "Dominic's" in connection with the new restaurant she is helping to

develop, and serves as general manager, at 630 E. West Carroll.

Rose found evidence that Mantia's restaurant infringed on "Dominic's" trademark, which Christie Mantia violated a 2007 settlement between her and her father, which Chris Mantia paid \$460,000 in damages. Christie's name "Dominic's" was used in a March 19

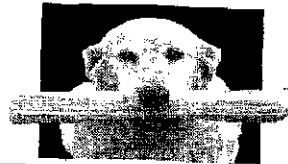
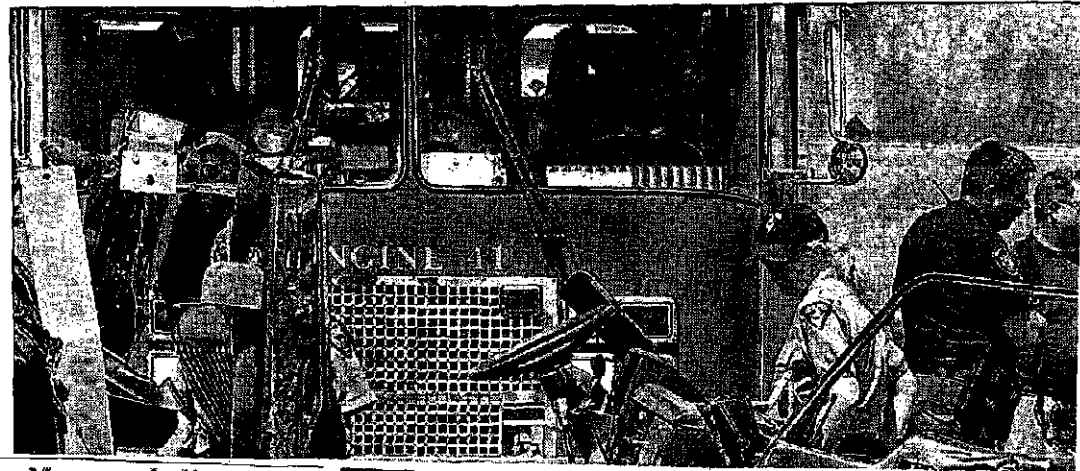
