ORDINANCE NO. 2008-10

AN ORDINANCE TO SET THE RATE FOR THE SALE OF SURPLUS WATER TO MOHAWK UTILITIES, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Malvern owns and operates a water supply distribution system with a capacity in excess of the amount currently needed to serve the present customers of the Village Water System, and

WHEREAS, Mohawk Utilities, Inc., a Private Utility Company, requires a supply of treated water to accomplish the operation of its water supply distribution system,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MALVERN:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Malvern, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 743.18, hereby authorizes the sale of surplus water to Mohawk Utilities, Inc., a private utility company.

SECTION 2. That said sale of water to Mohawk Utilities, Inc. shall be at the rate of \$3.25 per thousand gallons beginning July 1, 2008, \$3.62 per thousand gallons beginning July 1, 2009, and \$3.87 per thousand gallons beginning July 1, 2010.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is declare to be an emergency measure for the reason that it is necessary for the timely enactment and enforcement of the ongoing business of the Village of Malvern. The reason for the necessity is to provide the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio with evidence of uninterrupted surplus water supply to Mohawk Utilities, Inc. on or before June 30, 2008. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.

CALCULATION OF PURCHASED WATER RATES

The current rate structure for Mohawk Utilities, Inc. is a monthly, metered rate charge that is billed in arrears. Mohawk Utilities is purchasing supplemental bulk water from the Village of Malvern with no minimum purchase restriction. The current rate of \$3.25 per 1000 gallons will be increased as of July 1, 2009 to \$3.62 per 1000 gallons. The cost for purchasing this supplemental water will be equally distributed among the 949 residential customers. The purchased water cost will be a separate line item on the monthly water bill and will be for usage in arrears.

Calculation of bulk water adjustment cost per customer will be done monthly using the following procedure:

(Please note that this example assumes a monthly purchase of 90,000 gallons (this an average of the supplemental water purchase for the last twelve months as shown on page two of Exhibit B). The gallons purchased per month will fluctuate causing the monthly cost to residential customers to vary from this example. The purchase will be minimal depending on demand.)

- 1. Calculate the total monthly supplemental water charge using a rate of \$3.62 per 1000 gallons for 90,000 gallons. (90,000 divided by 1000 equals 90, 90 multiplied by 3.62 equals \$325.80 for the purchase price.)
- 2. Calculate the monthly cost per residential customer by dividing the total cost to Mohawk for purchased water by the number of residential customers. (\$325.80 divided by 949 equals .34)
- 3. Pass through this cost \$.34 to each residential customer on the monthly bill.

RE: Cost of supplemental water purchased from the Village of Malvern

Mohawk Utilities Customers:

Ohio Revised Code Section 4909.171 provides that when a water company such as Mohawk Utilities, which is under the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, purchases water from a municipal corporation or other local government, the water company can pass the charge for purchased water to its customers. This charge is based solely on the cost of the purchased water to Mohawk Utilities. The charge does not include any administrative cost, transportation expenses, or other fees, and is only the cost of purchased water.

In order to provide a reliable source of water, which can meet the peak demand requirements of our customers, the Village of Malvern has passed an ordinance allowing Mohawk Utilities, Inc. to purchase supplemental water from Malvern. The ordinance does not require Mohawk Utilities to have a minimum purchase per year. The new rate will be \$3.62 per 1000 gallons as of July 1, 2009.

This is not a new charge to the customer. It is an increase in the rate charged by the Village of Malvern instituted in the Ordinance No. 2008-10 passed by the village council June 2, 2008. Ordinance 2008-10 section 2 states the sale of water to Mohawk Utilities, Inc. shall be at the rate of \$3.25 per thousand gallons beginning July 1, 2008, \$3.62 per thousand gallons beginning July 1, 2009 and \$3.87 per thousand gallons beginning July 1, 2010.

The supplemental water charges will be a separate line item on the monthly water bills that you receive form Mohawk Utilities and will be only for water that has already been purchased form Malvern. Based on a purchase of 90,000 gallons per month the monthly charge to each residential customer would be \$.34 (assuming 949 residential customers). However, please note that the actual cost to the residential customer per month will vary from this amount depending upon the actual amount of supplemental water purchased during the preceding month.
