<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On February 27, 1997, the Commission issued an Entry on Rehearing in this case in which we substantially affirmed the Conjunctive Electric Service (CES) guidelines we issued by Finding and Order dated December 24, 1996. In our February 27, 1997 Entry on Rehearing, we addressed those allegations of error timely filed with the Commission pursuant to Section 4903.10, Revised Code.
- (2) On March 27, 1997, and March 28, 1997, respectively, The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) and the Utility Workers Union of America AFL-CIO (UWUA) filed what each purport to be applications for rehearing in this case. Neither DP&L nor UWUA specifically address those matters which this Commission changed in its February 27, 1997 Entry on Rehearing related to the guidelines adopted by Finding and Order dated December 24, 1996. DP&L and UWUA, directly or by reference, only reiterated allegations of error the Commission dealt with and rejected in the February 27, 1997, Entry on Rehearing. Thus, both of the applications are improper as applications for rehearing and cannot be considered by this Commission.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the filings of The Dayton Power and Light Company and the Utility Workers Union of America AFL-CIO dated March 27, 1997, and March 28, 1997, respectively, be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of interest.
