Verizon Access proposes to make updates to its tariff to comply with the P.U.C.O.'s CLEC switched access price cap rules set forth in 06-1344-TP-ORD. In addition, revisions are being made to include zone pricing whereby each of Zones 1-4 are comprised of the ILEC exchanges of Ameritech Ohio, Verizon Ohio, Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company and Embarq, respectively. These revisions also provide new tandem connect rates for MCImetro traffic involving leased switching and/or transport from the ILEC (formerly known as UNEP from the ILEC). These new rates include the ILEC tandem switching element. The tandem switching element is excluded from the facility-based tandem connect rates which are listed separately.

Verizon Access respectfully requests an effective date of September 19, 2009.



When a customer purchases Direct Connect, if the number of calls over the direct trunks has reached its maximum level, calls not able to be switched over the direct trunks will overflow/be routed to the customer via an ILEC access tandem. In that event, the customer will be assessed the Tandem Connect Trates for such calls.
