In its May 29, 2009 application for emergency rate relief in the above-referenced proceeding, Akron Thermal, Limited Partnership ("Akron Thermal") indicated that it would file its notice of intent to file the follow-on permanent rate increase application pursuant to the Commission's Standard Filing Requirements on or before September 1, 2009.
