The Commission finds:


- (1) On October 25, 1999, the Co-Operative Legislative Committee, Railroad Brotherhoods and Railroad Unions, State of Ohio filed the-above-captioned complaint case against Norfolk Southern Railway Company (NS) alleging NS created unsafe and hazardous conditions on its property by permitting excessive growth of vegetation.
- (2) On December 10, 1999, staff filed findings that the excessive growth of vegetation had been eliminated in this case. As the conditions giving rise to the complaint have been corrected, this complaint should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the Commission dismiss the complaint filed in this case and close this case of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the Commission serve a copy of this entry upon all parties of record.


