The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) This case was scheduled for hearing on September 10, 2009.
- (2) On September 4, 2009, The Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison or company) filed a motion for an extension of time to file expert testimony and a continuance of the hearing date. Further, Ohio Edison requested an expedited ruling on the motion.
- (3) In the memorandum in support of the motion, Ohio Edison stated its belief that the parties may be able to resolve the complainant's claim without the need for a hearing. Ohio Edison stated that, in order to permit these discussions to continue, the company requests an extension of the due date for the filing of expert testimony to September 24, 2009, and a continuance of the hearing date to October 1, 2009.
- (4) On September 9, 2009, Ohio Edison and Joe E. Snell contacted the attorney examiner via a telephone conference call. At that time, Mr. Snell confirmed that he had no objection to a continuance of the hearing date to October 1, 2009.
