ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 14, 2009, Hopewell Markets, Inc. dba Frattaroli's Sparkle Market (Hopewell) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison), an operating company of FirstEnergy Corporation. Hopewell claims that Ohio Edison has imposed an arbitrary, unjust, and unreasonable charge against Hopewell after the discovery that Hopewell's electric meter was damaged. Specifically, Hopewell objected to the recalculated usage charges for the thirteen months Hopewell's meter was determined to have been damaged.
- (2) On September 4, 2009, Hopewell and Ohio Edison filed a joint motion to dismiss, requesting that this complaint be dismissed with prejudice. The parties explain that they have reached an informal settlement of this matter that fully and finally resolves all issues in this proceeding.
- (3) The Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, the request to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is granted.
It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 09-725-EL-CSS be dismissed with prejudice. It is further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served on all parties of record.
