The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The complaint in this case, which alleges unfair billing practices, was filed on April 17, 2009, by the complainant, Bertha C. Tanner, against the respondent, AT&T Ohio.
- (2) Pursuant to an entry issued on June 25, 2009, a prehearing settlement conference was held at the Commission offices on July 14, 2009. However, the complainant failed to attend the settlement conference and has not since contacted the attorney examiner to inform him concerning whether she intends to further pursue this matter.
- (3) In view of the fact that this docket has remained inactive since the July 14, 2009, prehearing settlement conference, the complainant is directed to contact the attorney examiner by October 16, 2009, and make arrangements which would move forward any further prosecution of this case. Specifically, the complainant should, if it is her intention to proceed further, provide the attorney examiner with a suggested date for holding either another prehearing settlement conference or an evidentiary hearing in this matter. Failure of the complainant to do so will be considered cause for dismissal of the complaint.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the complainant in this case proceed under the terms set forth in Finding (3) of this entry or the complainant's case will be recommended for dismissal. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
