ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On August 28, 2009, The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (DEO) filed the instant application requesting an adjustment to its pipeline infrastructure replacement (PIR) program cost recovery rider.
- (2) By entry issued September 8, 2009, the attorney examiner, *inter alia*, established the procedural schedule in this case. Specifically, October 7, 2009, was set as the deadline for DEO to file a statement, informing the Commission whether the issues raised in the comments filed by Staff and intervenors had been resolved. In the event all of the issues raised in the comments were not resolved, the attorney examiner scheduled the evidentiary hearing for October 13, 2009.
- (3) On October 6, 2009, all of the parties in this case filed a joint motion for an alternation of the procedural schedule. The parties proposed the following procedural schedule:
  - (a) October 9, 2009, noon - Deadline for DEO to file a statement, informing the Commission whether the issues raised in the comments filed by Staff and intervenors have been resolved.
  - (b) October 9, 2009, noon - Deadline for DEO to file testimony regarding any unresolved issues.
  - (c) October 14, 2009, noon - Deadline for Staff and intervenors to file testimony regarding any unresolved issues.
  - (d) In the event all of the issues raised in the comments are not resolved, a hearing will commence on

October 16, 2009, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission.

- (4) Upon consideration of the parties' motion for an alteration of the procedural schedule in this case, the attorney examiner finds that the request is reasonable and should be granted. Therefore, the procedural schedule requested by the parties and set forth in finding (3) should be adopted, and the hearing should commence on October 16, 2009, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11<sup>th</sup> floor, hearing room F, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties' joint motion for an alteration of the procedural schedule be granted and that the procedural schedule set forth in finding (3) be adopted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
