Dear Ms. Jenkins:

On or about July 29, 2009, Heinz Frozen Food Company and Ohio Edison Company filed a joint application for approval of a special arrangement with a mercantile customer in the above-referenced docket. As part of this filing, the parties included Exhibit A, Exhibit 2 and Exhibit 3. Subsequent to this filing, Ohio Edison Company discovered that the customer's name on each of these exhibits was inconsistent with its legal name as indicated on the joint application. It also discovered errors related to the in-service date of several of the projects.

Accordingly, Ohio Edison Company submits twelve (12) copies of a revised set of exhibits with the following changes:

- Exhibits A, Exhibit 2 and Exhibit 3 – The customer name in the first column has been changed to "Heinz Frozen Food Company, a division of H. J. Heinz Company L.P.", so as to be consistent with the name included on both the joint application and related mercantile contract.
- Exhibit 2: Column 3 (lower) – The in-service dates for each of the three projects have been changed as follows: (i) Project 1 – from "2007" to "Jan-08"; (ii) Project 2 – from "2006" to "Jan-06"; and (iii) Project 3 – from "2007" to "June 08".
- Exhibit 2: Column 5 (upper) – as a result of the changes to the in-service dates, the adjusted usage has been modified as indicated on Exhibit 2

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- Exhibit 2: Last column "Reduced KW" – This column has been removed. The Company will not be claiming any demand reductions through these projects.

Please file the enclosed revised exhibits in the above-referenced docket, time-stamping the two extras and returning them to the undersigned in the enclosed envelope.

- 1 and 3 A third party measurement and verification summary performed by Brewer-Garnett Company, certifying to the projection of the savings identified in Exhibit 2, dated 5/07/08.  
This document uses the general principals of the International Performance Measurement Verification Protocol (IPMVP), Option B (measurement), which uses calculations based on measurements taken for a period of time.
- 2 A detailed description by ECO Engineering detailing the old (baseline) fixtures that were replaced versus the new fixtures installed, including wattage, number & type, and hours of use.  
Customer also provided receipts showing proof of purchase for new fixtures.  
The calculations conform to Option A<sub>s</sub> of the IPMVP, which relies on operational factors and commonly-accepted usage assumptions.
