ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On May 13, 2009, the Ohio State Legislative Board, United Transportation Union (UTU) filed a complaint alleging that CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSX) permitted unsafe and hazardous conditions to exist at its Rossford Yard.
- (2) On June 1, 2009, CSX filed an answer to the complaint.
- (3) On September 8, 2009, staff filed a memorandum indicating that CSX had eliminated the causes of the complaint and it recommended that the case be closed.
- (4) On October 7, 2009, the UTU filed a notice that it was withdrawing and dismissing its complaint with prejudice. The UTU's request to dismiss its complaint should be granted and the complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the UTU's request to dismiss its complaint be granted and that the UTU's complaint be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served on all parties of record.
