THIS IS IN REFERENCE TO THE ROADSIDE INSPECTION THAT OCCURRED ON OCTOBER, 29 2008 TO UNIT# 787 OF TRUX TRANSPORTATION, INC. THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO'S CASE# IS OH3259003751C.

AFTER SPEAKING WITH MR. JOHN JONES, TRUX TRANSPORTATION, INC. WAS LOOKING FOR A WAY TO REDUCE THE FINES THAT OCCURRED DURING THE INSPECTION.
