In each telephone exchange area where CBT proves that competition exists, the company will be granted limited pricing flexibility. CBT's pricing flexibility for basic local telephone service will be limited to an annual increase of no more than \$1.25. The annual increase for basic Caller ID service will be limited to no more than 50 cents.

Other telephone services such as second and third line local telephone service access lines, call waiting, call trace, Centrex access lines, private branch exchange trunks, per line number identification blocking, nonpublished number service and N11 access and usage (except 911) currently have limited pricing flexibility. Where CBT proves there is competition, these services will not be subject to any rate cap and may be priced at market-based prices.

Any customer may provide the PUCO with a written statement objecting to the application by November 16, 2009. Such objections should be sent to PUCO, Attn: Docketing Division, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, OH 43215-3793. Please reference Case No. 09-875-TP-BLS in the objection. The PUCO will consider any objections received when reviewing the application. The PUCO will decide on the application within 120 days.

At this time, CBT is not changing prices. Rather CBT is requesting to be able to change prices in the future in response to the competitive market. If the PUCO grants CBT pricing flexibility, CBT must provide customers with 30 days notice prior to any rate increases. Lifeline telephone rates for low income customers will not change as a result of this application.

Regardless of the outcome of this application, the PUCO retains regulatory oversight of service quality and consumer protections.
