Dear David:

As per our telephone conversation of October 8, 2009, I understand that Pyrotechnico does not intend to challenge the violations that were recorded during a September 12, 2008 inspection of one of your vehicles. As you know, a hearing has been scheduled for December 3, 2009 in Columbus, Ohio. Upon receipt of payment of the civil forfeiture due in the case (\$127.50), I will file a letter seeking cancellation of the hearing and dismissal of the case. Payment should be made by either certified check or money order made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio" and mailed to the PUCO Fiscal Division using the enclosed, pre-addressed envelope. Payment should be submitted in advance of the scheduled hearing date. If payment is not received, it will be our intention to move forward with the hearing on this matter.
