AGREEMENT OF ADOPTION

This Agreement of Adoption (the "Agreement"), dated $\frac{/c/28/o9}{}$, is entered into by and between Telephone Service Company ("TSC") and Time Warner Cable Information Services (Ohio), LLC d/b/a Time Warner Cable ("TWCIS (OH)"), pursuant to Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. TSC and TWCIS (OH) may be referred to individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties").

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. AGREEMENT OF ADOPTION

By TWCIS (OH)'s countersignature below, TWCIS (OH) hereby adopts and agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions of the Agreement for Interconnection between Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint") and TSC dated October 6, 2006 (the "Adopted Agreement") as that agreement exists on the date hereof and as amended herein. The Adopted Agreement was approved by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the "Commission") in Case No. 06-1431-TP-NAG.

As the terms and conditions of the Adopted Agreement are being adopted by TWCIS (OH) pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Act, TSC does not provide such terms and conditions to TWCIS (OH) as either a voluntary or negotiated agreement. TSC's performance of the Agreement does not in any way constitute a waiver by TSC of any position as to the Agreement or a portion thereof, nor does it constitute a waiver by TSC of all rights and remedies it may have to seek review of the Agreement, or to seek review in any way of any provisions included in the Agreement as a result of TWCIS (OH)'s adoption.

All services provided under this Agreement will be consistent with the decisions of the Federal Communications Commission, the Commission, and the courts having jurisdiction over this Agreement.

2. PARTIES:

TWCIS (OH) is hereby substituted in the Adopted Agreement for Sprint Communications Company L.P. and/or Sprint and TSC shall remain as the other Party (the "ILEC") to the Adopted Agreement. Except as modified herein, the Agreement shall in all other respects reflect the same terms as the Adopted Agreement.

3. TERM:

The Agreement will become effective upon execution of both Parties with the date of the second signature (the "Effective Date"), and, unless earlier terminated in accordance with its terms, will continue in force until December 1, 2009, which corresponds with the expiration of the Adopted Agreement. In accordance with the Adopted Agreement, the Agreement will automatically renew for successive one year periods, unless either Party requests renegotiation or gives notice of termination at least sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of the initial or any renewal term. In the event the Parties undertake renegotiation, and such renegotiation does not conclude prior to expiration of a

term, this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect until replaced by a superseding agreement. TWCIS (OH) shall file this Agreement with the Commission promptly upon receipt of the Agreement countersigned by TSC.

4. NOTICES:

Except as otherwise provided, all notices or other communications hereunder shall be deemed to have been fully given when made in writing and delivered in person, or overnight courier, or deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid, and addressed as follows:
