The Commission finds:

- (1) The complaint in this case, which alleges unfair billing practices, was filed on April 17, 2009, by the complainant, Bertha C. Tanner, against the respondent, AT&T Ohio. Pursuant to an entry issued on June 25, 2009, a prehearing settlement conference was held at the Commission offices on July 14, 2009. However, the complainant failed to attend the settlement conference and has not since contacted the attorney examiner to inform him concerning whether she intends to further pursue this matter.
- (2) On October 2, 2009, the attorney examiner issued an entry which directed the complainant to contact the attorney examiner by October 16, 2009, and make arrangements to move forward with the prosecution of the case in the manner outlined within the entry. The entry stated that the complainant's failure to do so would be considered cause for dismissal of the complaint.
- (3) To date, the complainant has neither contacted the attorney examiner, otherwise responded to the October 2, 2009 entry, nor took any other action of record to move forward in the prosecution of the complaint.
- (4) The Commission finds that, in light of the above findings, this case should now be dismissed for the complainant's failure to adequately prosecute this case.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case be dismissed in accordance with the above findings. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
