2. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL

This Application is made to amend Suburban Natural Gas Company's ("Suburban") tariff sheet that identifies Suburban's Gas Cost Recovery ("GCR") rate. Currently, with each GCR report Suburban files at the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission"), Suburban must also file a separate revised tariff sheet to reflect the new GCR rate. Suburban asks that the Commission allow Suburban to amend its GCR tariff sheet with language that adopts a new GCR Rate once a GCR report is filed at the Commission, without filing a separate revised tariff sheet to reflect the new GCR rate. This approach to updating the GCR rate is consistent with the approach used by several

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Ohio natural gas utilities, including Waterville Gas and Oil Company and Piedmont Gas Company.



SECTION V - RATES

GENERAL SERVICE TARIFF SCHEDULE

Applicable:

To all general service sales volumes, except customers located in the Villages of Deshler, McComb, Hoytville, Hamler, Holgate, and Malinta.

General Sales Rate:

All Mcf per meter, per month, \$2.84029 per Mcf.

A Customer Charge of \$9.18 per meter, per month, regardless of usage.

Gas Cost Recovery:

In addition to the above rates, all gas consumed is subject to the Gas Cost Recovery (GCR) as required by Commission Orders dated October 11, 1978 and October 18, 1979 in Case No. 76-515-GA-ORD. The GCR rate of \$ 6.7511 per Mcf shall apply to all sales in the Company's central Ohio service area.

Gross Receipts Tax Rider:

The amount due on all bills shall be adjusted for the Ohio gross receipts excise tax at the rate of 4.9810%.

MCF Tax Rider:

The amount on all bills shall be adjusted for the Ohio Excise (Mcf) tax as follows:

First 100 Mcf per account per month	\$.1593 per Mcf
Next 1900 Mcf per account per month	\$.0877 per Mcf
Over 2000 Mcf per account per month	\$.0411 per Mcf

All gas consumed is subject to the Gas Cost Recovery (GCR) per Mcf applied to the customer's monthly consumption. The final GCR rates shall be determined under the provisions of the uniform purchased gas adjustment as set forth in Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4901:1-14 and any subsequent revisions thereof, and by the lawful orders of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.
