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#### Exhibit C

Centennial Michiana License Company LLC d/b/a Centennial Communications Corp.

On November 6, 2009 AT&T, Inc. ("AT&T") acquired control of Centennial Communications Corp. ("Centennial"), the ultimate parent company of Centennial Michiana License Company LLC d/b/a Centennial Communications Corp. At closing, a wholly-owned subsidiary of AT&T, Independence Merger Sub Inc., was merged with and into Centennial, with Centennial being the surviving entity. Each share of Centennial common stock was converted into the right to receive \$8.50 in cash. Centennial thus became a wholly-owned subsidiary of AT&T. Centennial continues to own the stock of its subsidiaries, and Centennial and its subsidiaries will continue to hold all of the FCC authorizations and spectrum leases that they held prior to the merger. While AT&T will become the new parent of Centennial, no assignment of licenses or transfer of direct control of the FCC authorizations held by Centennial and its subsidiaries occurred as part of this transaction. Likewise, direct control of the Ohio certificate held by Centennial Michiana License Company LLC d/b/a Centennial Communications Corp., Certificate No. 90-5325, has not changed as a result of this transaction.

Because the transaction reported here is completely transparent to Centennial end users in Ohio, no customer notice is required and none has been issued.
