FINDING AND ORDER

The Commission finds:

- (1) The applicant, Suburban Natural Gas Company (Suburban or Company), is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On November 16, 2009, Suburban filed an application to amend that part of its tariff that identifies the Company's Gas Cost Recovery (GCR) rate. Suburban currently files its GCR rates monthly with the Commission. At the same time that the Company files its monthly GCR rate, it files a revised tariff sheet reflecting the new monthly GCR rate. Suburban is seeking Commission approval to amend its tariff sheet with language that automatically adopts a new GCR rate once a GCR report is filed at the Commission, without filing a separate tariff sheet.
- (3) The Commission has reviewed the amended tariff language and finds that the language is consistent with other natural gas companies' tariffs that automatically adopt the monthly GCR rate filings. Therefore, the Commission finds that the amended tariff is reasonable and in the public interest and that it should be approved.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the amended tariff filed on November 16, 2009, be approved. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Suburban is authorized to file four complete copies of its tariff, in final form, consistent with this Finding and Order. Suburban shall file one copy in this case docket and one copy in its TRF docket (or may file electronically as directed in Case No 06-900-AU-WVR). The remaining two copies shall be designated for

distribution to the Rates and Tariffs, Energy and Water Division of the Commission's Utilities Department. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Finding and Order be served upon all of the parties of record in this proceeding.






