<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On January 29, 2009, Terry A. Frazier filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (2) A prehearing conference was conducted on March 6, 2009, but the parties were unable to agree upon a settlement. By entry issued March 6, 2009, a hearing date of May 21, 2009, was scheduled. However, shortly before the hearing date, Mr. Frazier informed the attorney examiner by telephone that he would pay the civil forfeiture instead of going to hearing.
- (3) On November 24, 2009, Commission staff filed a letter noting that Mr. Frazier had paid the civil forfeiture in full.
- (4) Rule 4901:2-7-22, Ohio Administrative Code, provides that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all other proceedings regarding that violation.
- (5) In view of the payment of the forfeiture, this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
