With this transmittal, Verizon is revising FCC No. 14 to withdraw the revisions filed under Transmittal 1058 and reinstate the regulations presently in effect.


The actual filing documents may be viewed on the FCC's Internet website - www.fcc.gov - by doing the following:

Click on the part of the filing you want to view under the heading "View PDF". Each filing may have several parts, so look for the transmittal number on each line.

Following discussions with the Commission Staff, and under authority of Special Permission No. 09-032 of the FCC, Verizon is withdrawing revisions originally filed under Transmittal No. 1058 prior to them becoming effective on December 26, 2009, and reinstating the regulations that are presently in effect. Transmittal No. 1058 was filed on December 11, 2009, to revise regulations for the discontinuance of access service.

Supporting information as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission's rules is not required with this filing.


