5	record. The Ohio Power Siting Board has called for
6	hearing at this time and place Case No. 09-750-EL-BSB,
7	captioned in the Matter of the Application of BP-Husky
8	Refining, LLC for a Certificate of Environmental
9	Compatibility and Public Need for a 138/69 kilovolt
10	Substation Project. My name is Rebecca Hussey. I am
11	the Administrative Law Judge assigned to preside over
12	today's hearing.
13	I'll begin by taking appearances from the
14	parties, starting with the Company.
15	MR. BOEHM: Good morning, Your Honor. My
16	name is Kurt Boehm. I'm appearing on behalf of
17	BP-Husky Refining, LLC.
18	HEARING EXAMINER HUSSEY: Thank you very
19	much.
20	Staff.
21	MS. HAMMERSTEIN: Good morning, Your Honor.
22	On behalf of the Staff of the Ohio Power Siting Board,
23	Richard Cordray, Ohio Attorney General, by Anne L.
24	Hammerstein, Assistant Attorney General, Public
25	Utilities Section, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus,

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1	Ohio, 43215, and I'd also like to enter the appearance
2	of Margaret A. Malone, Assistant Attorney General,
3	Environmental Enforcement Section, 30 East Broad

5	HEARING EXAMINER HUSSEY: Thank you. Are
6	there any preliminary matters or motions that need to
7	be addressed before we take the first witness?
8	MS. HAMMERSTEIN: I just have a couple of
9	exhibits to mark, Your Honor.
10	HEARING EXAMINER HUSSEY: Okay. Go ahead.
11	MS. HAMMERSTEIN: I'd like to mark as Staff
12	Exhibit No. 1 the Staff Report of Investigation in
13	BP-Husky Refining 138/69 kilovolt Substation, Case No.
14	09-750-EL-BSB. That was docketed on January 5th of
15	2010.
16	HEARING EXAMINER HUSSEY: Okay. Staff
17	Exhibit No. 1; correct?
18	MS. HAMMERSTEIN: Yes.
19	HEARING EXAMINER HUSSEY: So marked.
20	MS. HAMMERSTEIN: Then I'd like to have
21	marked the following document as Joint Exhibit No. 1,
22	the Joint Stipulation and Recommended Findings of Fact
23	and Conclusions of Law, docketed in this matter on
24	January 26th of 2010, and that the Stipulation is
25	signed by the Staff of the Power Siting Board and

2	HEARING EXAMINER HUSSEY: Okay. So marked as
3	Joint Exhibit No. 1.
4	MS. HAMMERSTEIN: Thank you, Your Honor. The
5	Staff of the Power Siting Board calls James O'Dell to
6	the stand.
7	HEARING EXAMINER HUSSEY: Okay. Raise your
8	right hand.
9	JAMES S. O'DELL,
10	being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was

19	Q. Good morning, Mr. O'Dell.
20	A. Morning.
21	Q. By whom are you employed?
22	A. Public Utilities Commission of Ohio and the
23	Ohio Power Siting Board.
24	Q. How long have you been employed with the
25	Commission and the Board?

1 Α. Close to 19 years. 2 Ο. What is your position? 3 Utilities Specialist 3. Α. 4 Could you please describe your educational Q. 5 background and experience as they relate to your job б duties? 7 Α. Sure. I have a Bachelor of Science in 8 Political Science from The Ohio State University in 9 1988, also a Bachelor of Science in Sociology in 1997 10 from The Ohio State University. I have a Master's in 11 City and Regional Planning from The Ohio State University in 1992, and I've completed significant 12 13 course work at Central Michigan University for a second 14 Masters's in Public Policy. 15 And can you tell us how many cases you've Ο. 16 participated in on behalf of the Board? 17 Probably over 200 proceedings before the Α. 18 Power Siting Board during that time and over three 19 dozen major application proceedings as well. 20 Q. Thank you. Are you familiar with the 21 documents that were just marked as Staff Exhibit 1 and 22 Joint Exhibit 1? 23 Α. Yes, I am. 24 How did you gain your knowledge of those two Ο. 25 exhibits and the other information in the record in

1 this case? 2 Α. I was the lead analyst for this project, and 3 we conducted a full investigation of the proposed 4 substation, and I participated in the negotiations with 5 the Applicant regarding the Stipulation. 6 Okay. Do you have any changes or corrections 0. 7 to be made to either Staff Exhibit 1 or Joint Exhibit 1 8 at this time? 9 No, I do not. Α. 10 Is the information contained in Staff Exhibit 0. 11 1 and Joint Exhibit 1 true and correct, to the best of 12 your knowledge? 13 Α. Yes, it is. 14 Given your education, experience, and the 0. 15 investigation you conducted along with the Staff in 16 this case, what is your recommendation to the Power 17 Siting Board regarding Joint Exhibit 1? 18 I would recommend that the Board adopt it in Α. 19 its entirety. 20 MS. HAMMERSTEIN: Thank you, Your Honor. The 21 witness is available for cross-examination. 22 HEARING EXAMINER HUSSEY: Does any other 23 party have any questions for Mr. O'Dell at this time? 24 MR. BOEHM: I don't have any questions for 25 Mr. O'Dell at this time.
