## Dear Examiner Stenman:

As a result of a "Level II" inspection performed on July 16, 2009 on a vehicle owned/operated by Tauro Brothers Trucking Co., it was determined that the carrier then had in force inadequate public liability and property damage insurance for that type of vehicle. After requesting and having an initial conference to discuss the violation with the Staff, Tauro did obtain, and Staff was able to verify, the requisite level of insurance required under the federal regulations for a "hopper" type vehicle. In light of the remedial action taken by Tauro, the Staff agrees to waive and not pursue the \$500.00 civil forfeiture earlier assessed. The violation, however, will stand for purposes of Tauro's Safety Net record. Tauro, through its attorney, has agreed to withdraw its request for a hearing on this matter.
