This letter is confirmation and notification of completion of construction work performed on the above noted case for the Dayton Power and Light Company transmission line relocation project at the Greene County Airport. Specifically, construction started on October 19, 2009, with initial structural work on the replacement steel pole structures. All structural work, conductor relocation and placing the lines back in normal operation was completed on November 20, 2009. Clean up and right of way restoration followed, but this was not totally completed until the week of February 8, 2010, when the original steel pole structures could be removed from the project site on frozen ground without causing damage to the airport property.
