Thursday Morning Session, February 11, 2010.

HEARING EXAMINER PRICE: Let's go on the record. Good morning. The Public Utilities Commission has set for hearing at this time and this place Case No. 08-221-GA-GCR in the Matter of the Regulation of the Purchased Gas Adjustment Clause Contained Within the Rate Schedules of Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. and Related Matters, and Case No. 07-121-GA-FOR in the Matter of the Long-Term Forecast Report of Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. and Related Matters. My name is Gregory Price. I'm the Attorney Examiner assigned to preside at today's hearing.

Since we've had a lengthy recess, let's take the appearances of the parties here today, starting with the Company.

MR. SEIPLE: On behalf of Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc., I'd like to enter the appearances of Stephen B. Seiple and Brooke Leslie, 200 Civic Center Drive, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

HEARING EXAMINER PRICE: Thank you.

Mr. Sauer.

MR. SAUER: Thank you, Your Honor. On behalf of the residential consumers of Columbia Gas of Ohio,

Janine Migden-Ostrander, Consumers' Counsel, Larry S. Sauer and Joseph P. Serio, 10 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

HEARING EXAMINER PRICE: Staff.

MR. REILLY: Thank you, Your Honor. On behalf of the Staff of the Public Utilities Commission, Richard Cordray, Attorney General, Duane Luckey, Section Chief, Steve Reilly and John Jones, Assistant Attorney Generals, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

HEARING EXAMINER PRICE: Thank you. Do we have any preliminary matters to discuss before we take our witnesses today?

MR. REILLY: Your Honor, we have one. Staff would like to -- as the Bench might remember, there was a revision, certain revisions filed by the consulting group, Liberty, to the two Commission-Ordered -- Commission-Ordered Exhibit 2, which was the Management Performance Audit in this case. I would like to mark those revisions as Commission-Ordered Exhibit 3 and move their admission into evidence. I've already provided a copy to the court reporter. I can provide a copy to the Bench, if you'd like.

HEARING EXAMINER PRICE: Please.

MR. REILLY: These were docketed on

6 1 March 23rd, 2009, in this case. We would move their 2 admission into evidence and all Commission-ordered 3 exhibits and Staff-offered exhibits -- I don't think 4 there were any Staff-offered exhibits into evidence. 5 HEARING EXAMINER PRICE: No, and I believe 6 you admitted the other Commission-ordered exhibits. 7 MR.
