3 I. INTRODUCTION

- 4 Q1. Please state your name, occupation and business address.
- 5 A1. My name is Roxie Edwards. I am employed by The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a
- 6 Dominion East Ohio ("DEO" or "Company") as a Customer Relations Support Manager. My
- 7 business address is 1201 E. 55th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44103.
- 8 Q2. What is the purpose of your testimony?
- 9 A2. My testimony explains the account history of Randy Coleman, Sr. for natural gas service
- provided to 5333 Saint Andrews St., NW, Canton, Ohio 44708, account No. 6500033515913.
- 11 My testimony concludes: (1) DEO timely provided Mr. Coleman with the notice required by
- 12 Commission rules informing him that he had enrolled with Interstate Gas Supply ("IGS") as his
- 13 natural gas supplier on October 9, 2008, and that he had until October 23, 2008 to notify DEO if
- 14 he wished to cancel his enrollment; (2) Mr. Coleman did not contact DEO on or before October
- 15 23, 2008 to cancel his enrollment; and (3) Mr. Coleman has failed to pay substantial arrearages
- on undisputed charges, thereby warranting disconnection of service.
- 17 II. BACKGROUND AND QUALIFICATIONS
- 18 Q3. Please describe your work history.
- 19 A3. I have been employed by DEO since 1978 in various positions related to customer
- service, including call center representative, and representative in the consumer affairs, billing
- and customer relations departments.

- 1 Q4. What are your current job responsibilities?
- 2 A4. I am responsible for responding to general billing inquiries, administering payment plans
- and options for repayment of delinquent accounts, and handling customer billing disputes.
- 4 Q5. What information have you reviewed to prepare your testimony?
- 5 A5. I have reviewed the Complaint filed by Mr. Coleman on September 18, 2009. I have also
- 6 reviewed documents pertaining to the history and current status of Mr. Coleman's account,
- 7 particularly with respect to billing and payments, and documents pertaining to DEO's notifying
- 8 Mr. Coleman of his October 9, 2008 enrollment with IGS. The documents are maintained by
- 9 DEO in the ordinary course of business and are business records of DEO.
- 10 Q6. What is your understanding of the dispute that gives rise to Mr. Coleman's
- 11 Complaint?
- 12 A6. According to the Complaint, Mr. Coleman claims he "never gave permission" to IGS to
- be his natural gas supplier. He also claims to have "never received any written confirmation" of
- 14 his enrollment with IGS.
- 15 HI. IGS ENROLLMENT
- 16 Q7. When did Mr. Coleman establish gas service with DEO?
- 17 A7. Mr. Coleman became the customer of record at 5333 Saint Andrews St., NW, Canton,
- 18 Ohio 44708 on August 23, 2007.
- 19 Q8. What is DEO's Energy Choice Program?
- 20 A8. Generally speaking, pursuant to Chapter 4901:1-29, Ohio Administrative Code
- 21 ("O.A.C."), DEO's Energy Choice Program allows eligible customers to purchase natural gas
- from a Competitive Retail Natural Gas ("CRNG") supplier, such as IGS. CRNG suppliers must
- 23 be registered with the Commission in order to serve customers. The relationship between DEO

- and CRNG suppliers is governed by DEO's General Terms and Conditions of Energy Choice
- 2 Pooling Service, which are part of DEO's tariffs. Customers who wish to buy gas from a CRNG
- 3 supplier continue to receive their delivery service from DEO under DEO's Energy Choice
- 4 Transportation Service ("ECTS") tariff.
- 5 Q9. What are the eligibility criteria for customers to participate in Energy Choice?
- 6 A9. DEO's ECTS tariff provides two main criteria for eligibility under the ECTS rate
- 7 schedule. First, the customer must have purchased or otherwise arranged to receive all of their
- 8 natural gas requirements from a qualified CRNG supplier. Second, the customer must have no
- 9 arrears for 30 days or more, or, if eligible, be on a current payment plan to discharge an
- arrearage. Customers who have not broken more than one payment plan in the preceding 12
- 11 months are also Choice-eligible.
- 12 Q10. Please describe the enrollment process for the Energy Choice program.
- 13 A10. After a supplier enrolls a new customer, the supplier sends DEO an electronic file
- regarding the customer's request for enrollment with that supplier. DEO uses the information
- provided by the supplier to verify whether the customer is eligible for service under the ECTS
- rate schedule. If the customer is eligible, Rule 4901:1-29-06(C), O.A.C. requires DEO to
- 17 "provide a written notice to customers that allow customers to rescind their enrollment with a
- 18 [CRNG] supplier or governmental aggregator within seven business days from the postmark date
- of the notice." If the customer is not Choice-eligible, DEO notifies the customer and the supplier
- and no change is made to the customer's service.
- 21 Q11. How long does the enrollment process take?
- 22 A11. Ordinarily, one to two billing cycles.

- 1 Q12. What is your understanding of the purpose of Rule 4901:1-29-06(C)?
- 2 A12. My understanding of the intent of the Commission's rule is to prevent "slamming," or the
- 3 unauthorized enrollment with a CRNG supplier without the customer's consent.
- 4 Q13. Did DEO receive a request for CRNG enrollment for Mr. Coleman's account?
- 5 A13. Yes. On October 9, 2008, IGS sent an electronic enrollment request to DEO informing
- 6 DEO that Mr. Coleman had chosen to enroll with IGS as his CRNG supplier. DEO determined
- 7 Mr. Coleman was eligible for Energy Choice participation. As such, on October 10, 2008, DEO
- 8 provided Mr. Coleman the notice required by Rule 4901:1-29-06(C) by sending him the written
- 9 "Energy Choice Program Confirmation of Supplier" (the "Confirmation"). A true and correct
- 10 copy of the Confirmation referenced in my testimony is attached as DEO Exhibit 1.1. The
- 11 Confirmation informed Mr. Coleman that he had enrolled with IGS as his CRNG supplier. The
- 12 Confirmation instructed Mr. Coleman to contact DEO by no later than October 23, 2008 to
- 13 cancel his enrollment. DEO thus gave Mr. Coleman the required 7 business days to contact DEO
- and cancel his IGS enrollment. The Confirmation was sent to Mr. Coleman at the address for the
- account and was not returned to DEO as undeliverable.
- 16 Q14. Did Mr. Coleman contact DEO on or before October 23, 2008 regarding the
- 17 Confirmation or his enrollment with IGS?
- 18 A14. No. I have reviewed the account history for Mr. Coleman's account as documented by
- 19 DEO's Customer Information System. The information contained in DEO's Customer
- 20 Information System is kept in the ordinary course of business and maintained as business records
- 21 of DEO. True and correct copies of the Customer Information System materials referenced in
- 22 my testimony are attached collectively as DEO Exhibit 1.2. DEO's Customer Information
- 23 System shows that Mr. Coleman did not contact DEO at all between October 9, 2008 and

- 1 October 23, 2008. Mr. Coleman did contact DEO regarding his IGS enrollment on March 31,
- 2 2009, when he and someone identifying herself as Mr. Coleman's wife telephoned DEO. During
- 3 the March 31, 2009 telephone call, Mr. and Mrs. Coleman said that they had not authorized the
- 4 enrollment with IGS. DEO informed Mr. and Mrs. Coleman that DEO sent the Confirmation on
- 5 October 10, 2008 and that the enrollment with IGS was confirmed and processed when the
- 6 Colemans failed to respond to the Confirmation. DEO instructed Mr. and Mrs. Coleman to
- 7 contact IGS directly if they were disputing their IGS enrollment. DEO also informed the
- 8 Colemans that DEO could not make any adjustment to the account absent instructions to do so
- 9 from IGS.
- 10 Q15. Did Mr. or Mrs. Coleman contact DEO again regarding the IGS enrollment?
- 11 A15. Yes. DEO's Customer Information System (DEO Exhibit 1.2) indicates that, on July 30,
- 12 2009, Mr. Coleman again contacted DEO regarding the IGS charges. DEO once again explained
- the basis for the IGS supplier charges on Mr. Coleman's account. The call was disconnected by
- 14 Mr. Coleman.
- 15 Q16. Has DEO discussed the account with anyone else?
- 16 A16. Yes. Based on information in DEO's Customer Information System (DEO Exhibit 1.2), on
- 17 September 11, 2009, DEO received a call from the Office of Ohio Consumers' Counsel ("OCC")
- on Mr. Coleman's behalf regarding the IGS enrollment. DEO explained the history, process and
- 19 procedures related to Mr. Coleman's enrollment. The OCC representative said that he was
- satisfied with DEO's explanation. DEO received no further calls from Mr. or Mrs. Coleman,
- OCC or any other party about Mr. Coleman's IGS enrollment after September 11, 2009.

- 1 Q17. How long was Mr. Coleman enrolled with IGS as his CRNG supplier?
- 2 A17. IGS was the CRNG supplier for Mr. Coleman's account for monthly bills issued from
- 3 December 2008 through September 2009. For monthly bills issued prior to December 2008 and
- 4 after September 2009, DEO has been the natural gas supplier for Mr. Coleman's account. True
- 5 and correct copies of the bills issued from December 2008 through February 2010 referenced in
- 6 my testimony are attached collectively as DEO Exhibit 1.3. All charges and fees appearing on
- 7 these bills are bona fide and accurate.
- 8 Q18. Were the IGS supplier charges identified on Mr. Coleman's bills from December
- 9 2008 through September 2009?
- 10 A18. Yes. As required by Rule 4901:1-29-12, O.A.C., the bills issued for Mr. Coleman's
- account from December 2008 through September 2009 displayed that IGS was the CRNG
- supplier for the account. The bills separately itemized the IGS supplier charges from the DEO
- 13 distribution charges.
- 14 IV. ACCOUNT ARREARAGE
- 15 Q19. Is Mr. Coleman current on his DEO account?
- 16 A19. No. Mr. Coleman's account arrearage through his February 4, 2010 bill is \$3,645.72.
- 17 The arrearage includes in part \$1,524.17 for services rendered prior to December 2008, when
- 18 Mr. Coleman's IGS enrollment began. The arrearage total also includes \$996.52 in unpaid
- 19 charges for bills issued since October 2009, after Mr. Coleman's IGS enrollment ended. DEO
- 20 has not received a payment on the account since June 8, 2009, almost nine months ago.
- 21 Q20. Is Mr. Coleman's account subject to disconnection?
- 22 A20. Yes. DEO understands that, pursuant to the Commission's September 24, 2009 entry in
- 23 this proceeding, DEO may not disconnect service based upon Mr. Coleman's failure to pay

1 charges in dispute in this proceeding. The only charges disputed in the Complaint are charges

2 incurred during his IGS enrollment from December 2008 through September 2009. As the

3 Commission's September 24, 2009 entry also affirms, DEO is not prohibited from disconnecting

4 Mr. Coleman's account for failure to pay charges accrued on his account prior to December 2008

5 or after September 2009, as these charges and fees are expressly not in dispute. Accordingly,

6 DEO has included the required "Shut-Off Notice" on each bill issued for the account from

7 October 2009 through February 2010, informing Mr. Coleman that he is required to pay

8 outstanding arrearages on the account to avoid disconnection, and encouraging him to contact

9 DEO regarding the "Shut-Off Notice." (DEO Exhibit 1.3.) DEO has also complied with the

10 Commission's winter disconnection requirements by providing Mr. Coleman, by telephone

11 contact at the telephone number designated for the account, the information required by Rule

4901:1-18-05(B). DEO provided this information by contact with a live person on November

13 30, 2009, by leaving Mr. Coleman answering machine messages on December 17, 2009 and

14 January 19, 2010, and by contact with a live person again on February 18, 2010. (DEO Exhibit

1.2.) The person who answered the telephone on February 18, 2010 hung up before the call

16 could be completed.

17 Q21. Does this conclude your testimony?

18 A21. Yes.



 The plan amount (current amount due, plus one-sixth of your past-due balance) will be stated on your first Energy Choice bill.



CHANGES IN GAS BASE RATES

On October 15, 2008, in case number 07-0829-GA-AIR, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) granted Dominion East Ohio a revenue increase of \$37.5 million, which is reflected in an approximate 3.7% increase in base rates charged on customer bills. All approved rate changes are effective October 16, 2008, except as noted. Explanations of new items and fees will not appear on the back of bills until a later date.

Energy Choice Transporation Service

Residential and small commercial customers who use less than 3,000 MCF (thousand cubic feet) per year and who purchase their gas supply from an Energy Choice supplier will see a Basic Monthly Charge of \$12.50. The Usage-Based Charges are initially set at \$2.27 per thousand cubic feet (MCF) for the first 50 MCF per month. These rates have been redesigned to include most of the fixed costs for delivering gas, such as the pipes in the ground, meters, billing and meter reading in the new basic monthly charge, along with reduced fees for delivery based on gas usage. Residential customers, who use on average 99.1 MCF annually, will see their monthly delivery costs increase by approximately \$2.98 per month.

Service & Delivery Charges

Basic Monthly Charge. With the rate redesign, this new charge replaces the Monthly Service Charge for the GSS and ECTS rate schedules. It includes the fixed costs for delivering gas, which do not change with usage. It will also include the following charges:

AMR Cost Recovery. This charge recovers expenses associated with the installation of automated meter reading

(AMR) equipment. It will be implemented in early 2009.

PIR Cost Recovery. This charge recovers expenses associated with the pipeline infrastructure replacement (PIR)

program. This charge is expected to be implemented in November 2009.

Usage-Based Charges. These charges recover a portion of the costs associated with delivering gas to the meter as well as applicable riders and taxes. They do not include the cost of the gas. Also included is the new **Demand Side Management** Rider. This charge recovers the cost to promote energy efficiency and conservation.

Gross Receipts Tax. An Ohio tax levied on public utilities. Applies to all charges billed by the company, excluding security deposits and charges billed on behalf of Energy Choice suppliers and separate entities.

Other Fees

Reconnection Fee. This fee increases to \$33 and is charged to reconnect service at a service address following a shutoff for nonpayment.

Returned Payment Fee. A new fee of \$12 for each returned item tendered or authorized as payment on the customer's account and returned for any reason, including insufficient or uncollected funds, closed account, revoked authorization or stop payment.

Investigation Fee. A new fee of \$112 to be levied in those circumstances where Dominion East Ohio has reasonable proof of the customer's fraudulent or damaging practice related to gas service.

Late Payment Charge. Beginning in April 2009, a 1.5% late payment charge (LPC) may be added to the past-due amount of your bill if you do not pay the minimum required amount by the bill due date. For Payment Plan and Budget customers, the LPC late charge applies only to the past-due plan amount.

One-Third Option - Between November 1 and April 15, customers can pay one third of their total bill to avoid a shutoff of service.
