ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On September 18, 2009, Randy Coleman Sr. (complainant) filed a complaint against The East Ohio Gas Company, d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (Dominion) and Interstate Gas Supply, Inc., d/b/a IGS Energy (IGS), alleging that Dominion and IGS failed to correctly bill him for natural gas used at a property occupied by the complainant. Specifically, the complainant alleged that, either Dominion, IGS, or both, changed his natural gas supplier from Dominion to IGS without his consent.
- (2) On October 14, 2009, both Dominion and IGS filed their answers to the complaint, denying the material allegations in the complaint. Dominion also filed a motion to dismiss stating that it has complied with its obligation to give the complainant an opportunity to rescind his enrollment with IGS and that the complainant did not set forth reasonable grounds for complaint.
- (3) By entry issued on January 21, 2010, this matter was set for a hearing on March 9, 2010.
- (4) On March 4, 2010, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint. In light of the parties' motion, the March 9, 2010, hearing should be held in abeyance pending the Commission's consideration of the motion.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the hearing currently scheduled for March 9, 2010, be held in abeyance pending consideration of the parties' motion to dismiss the case. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
