- (4) The parties in this case are directed to participate in a prehearing settlement conference on April 26, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (5) The purpose of the prehearing settlement conference is to determine whether this matter can be resolved informally. In the event that a settlement is not reached at the conference, the attorney examiner will conduct a discussion of procedural issues at the conclusion of the prehearing settlement conference. Procedural issues for discussion may include discovery dates, possible stipulations of facts, and potential hearing dates.

ORDERED, That a prehearing settlement conference be scheduled in accordance with Finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
