As per our telephone conversation of March 22, 2010, I understand that you do not intend to challenge the violation that was recorded during a March 18, 2009 inspection of a vehicle driven by you. As you know, a hearing was originally scheduled for February 17, 2010 in Columbus, Ohio and was continued to March 23, 2010 at your request. Upon receipt of payment of the civil forfeiture due in the case (\$100.00), I will file a letter seeking dismissal of the case.
